Site Activities

Each year, WM plans for ongoing construction and maintenance to Eagle Valley's landfill gas collection system/renewable energy production facilities. Currently, WM is developing a plan for the initial phase of 2022 landfill gas construction. This will take place primarily in the NW corner of the site. The upcoming work will involve adding vertical wells for additional gas collection and odor control, which will likely be completed this February. WM will be installing collection wells near the active cell area - (cells 11 & 2) - to replace recently lost collection due to decommissioned wells. As waste ages and settles, it is not unusual for landfill gas wells to require decommissioning and new wells installed in their place. It is our goal to continue to provide innovative/sustainable solutions to best serve our environment, and our communities - for tomorrow.
